THOUGHT FOR TODAY

Hebrews 1:1-4 Meditation: The author to the Hebrews warns against two kinds of sins: *transgression* and *disobedience*. Transgression literally means *to step across a line*. God tells us through his word and by our conscience what is right and wrong and what he expects of us. To step across that line is to sin. Disobedience is related to hearing. It literally means *imperfect hearing*, or *careless hearing*. In the end it means the *unwillingness to hear the voice of God*. God has spoken to us through his own Son. It is both an awesome privilege to hear the word of God and to be changed by his life-giving word, and an awesome responsibility to believe what God says and to obey it. Are you attentive to God's word?

"Lord Jesus Christ, your word is life and truth. Nourish me by your life-changing word and help me to study it diligently and to conform my life according to it."
