

Ways to Use the Weekly Study Guides

Here is how it works for our quizzers at Anderson (IN) Wesley. Feel free to use the study guides in any way you think will work for your quizzers.

1. Each week (except for tournament weeks) we take the one-page study guide, make copies, and then give it to the quizzers. We try to cover the entire chapter while also keeping the format to one page.
2. We expect all of the quizzers to write out the answers and then bring it back the next week to quiz practice. Another option is to give them an electronic copy and have them type out the answers.
3. They must complete the study guide each week in order to be eligible to attend the tournament that month. We keep a chart showing who has completed which study guides. Quizzers get a sticker and small piece of candy for completing and returning the study guide the next week.
4. More advanced quizzers may choose to memorize and quote the chapter the next week instead of doing the study guides. They get a larger sticker and larger piece of candy when they memorize and quote a chapter.
5. For the quiz practice following the monthly tournament, we choose some of the questions from the study guides, simplify them some, and then give the quizzers a written 20-question test. Quizzers must pass all but one monthly test in order to be eligible to attend national Quiz Finals in the summer. To pass, veteran quizzers must score 15 out of 20, and newcomers to Quiz Finals must score 12 out of 20. Quotes can be used as bonus points. (We have found some kind of accountability like this is particularly helpful when you have several teams at your church, though it is simple enough that almost all of our quizzers pass the tests.)
